

A to Z of Sutton Streets

This is a directory of streets listed in the 1901 Census that comprised the wards of West and East Sutton in St. Helens. By the name of each street is the district number and ward (*WS = West Sutton, ES = East Sutton*). Some long streets are listed in more than one district. - Normans Road (*part of*) renamed Houghton Road in 1899
- Rigbys Lane renamed Gartons Lane in 1902
- Thieves Lane renamed Eaves Lane in 1902
